The Central Texas Food Bank is a leader in the fight against hunger for more than 40 years, with a mission to nourish hungry people and lead the community in the fight against hunger. 300 Partner Agencies have joined the Food Bank to serve families in 21 Central Texas counties at soup kitchens, food pantries, after-school programs, snack programs and other service sites.



Austin Helps Honduras Education Celebration Trip

Ten people are traveling to Juticalpa, Honduras, January 28-February 3, to celebrate students and graduates supported by AHH Scholarships. Members of Riverbend Church and St. Martin's formed AHH after Hurricane Mitch destroyed thousands of homes and took thousands of lives in Honduras and other Central American countries in 1998. During the construction of about 75 houses by AHH, the need for educating young people beyond the 6th grade was recognized, and the focus of the non-profit became education. An elementary school was built and a scholarship program established to aid impoverished families to send their children to school beyond the government-supported 6th grade. During its 21 years, over 1,000 annual scholarships have been awarded, and there have been 370+ graduates of high school and university.



An exciting part of the trip will be the presentation of Project Noteworthy band instruments and instructional materials to two middle schools in Juticalpa. Thanks to all who donated instruments or money to make this happen.
